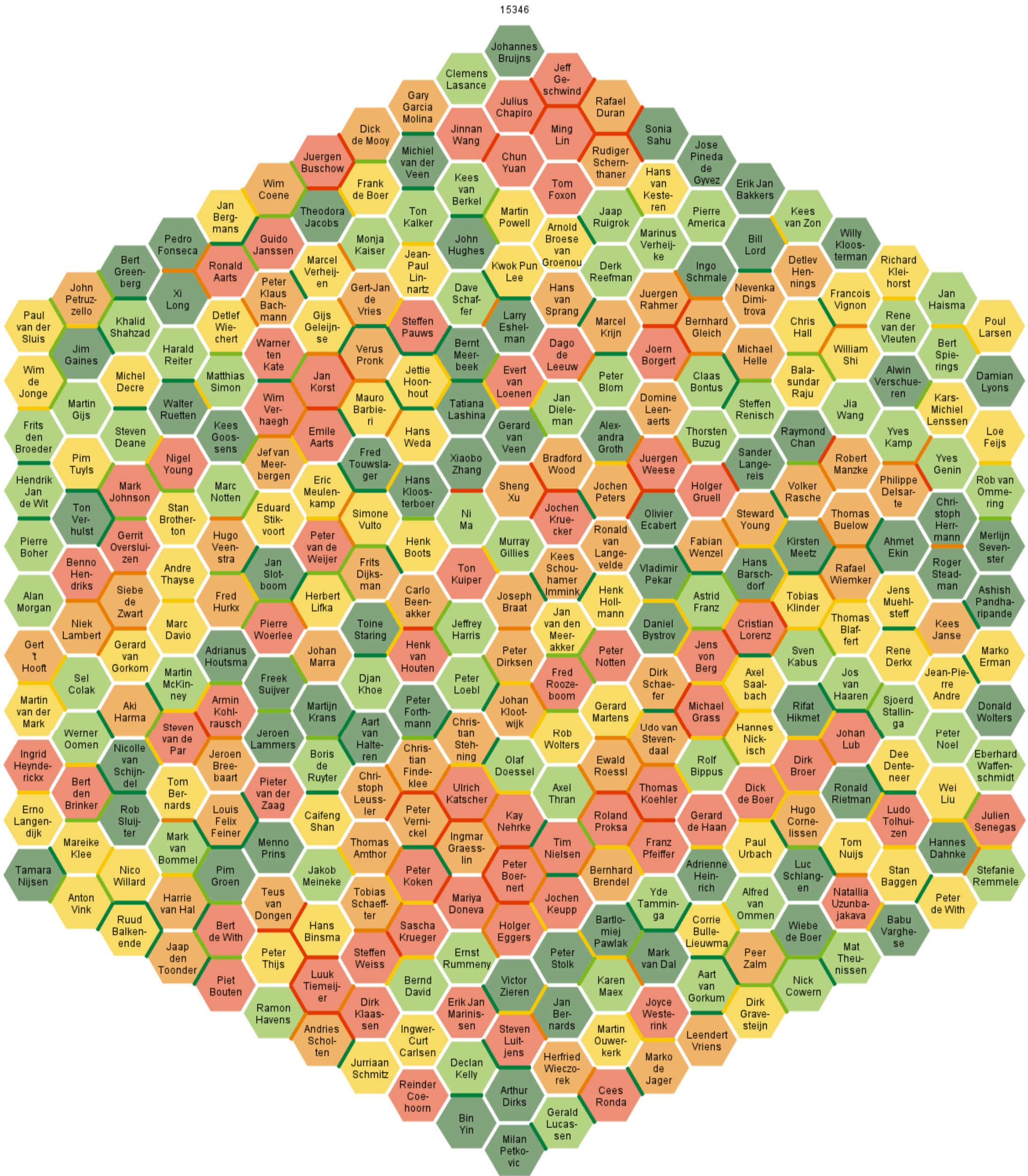


Busy Bees: co-authorship at Philips Research

Based on manuscripts and reports visible in the Portal-to-Research published in [1973-2022]



The above hexagonal grid contains 331 hexagons. The persons that have the largest number of manuscripts and reports visible in the Portal-to-Research are assigned to the hexagons such that the sum of the number of joint publications summed over the direct neighbors is maximized, using a local search approach. The hexagons are given a background color that is indicative of the number of publications of the given person, using five colors ranging from green (fewer) to red (more). In addition, the boundaries between hexagons are also given a color: white if the corresponding persons do not have publications in common, and five additional colors ranging from green (fewer) to red (red).
